Description

An extremely powerful emulsifying solvent based anti-bacterial cleaner for the removal of grease, oil, wax, bitumen and some types of paint from concrete and a wide range of other surfaces.

Advantages

- May be diluted with water for use on areas of light contamination.

Application Instructions

Where heavy oil or grease contamination is present Desolve should be applied undiluted on to the surface and agitated, after which the surface should be flushed with clean water.

For general cleaning and washing down Desolve may be diluted with up to an equal volume of water. Agitate where possible and wash off with clean water.

Measures should be taken to ensure that the waste water does not enter any drainage systems.

Packaging

Desolve is available in 5 and 25 litre containers.

Storage

Desolve may separate on prolonged storage. This is easily reconstituted by agitation. Store away from foodstuffs and out of the reach of children. Protect from frost.

Health & Safety

Goggles and gloves should be worn, if using in confined spaces provide adequate ventilation.
