Description

Linemark is a styrene acrylic copolymer line marking paint designed for application to a wide range of surfaces, offering excellent colour stability, it is both hard wearing and chemical resistant.

Advantages

- Easy application single pack system.
- Quick drying, can be trafficked between 4-6 hours.
- Excellent colour stability.
- Very good adhesion to most substrates.

Surface Preparation

Ensure the surface is dry and free from laitance. Oils and grease should be removed using Desolve. Damaged and worn areas should be repaired using Epicon F.S. Mortar. It is strongly recommended that on old or suspect floors a test patch be applied and evaluated.

Application Instructions

Linemark should be stirred thoroughly prior to use, application is by brush or roller with one coating being normally sufficient but a second coat can be applied to give a higher build (second coat can be applied after 4 hours).

Limitations

Linemark is not recommended for coating composition tiles, Bitumen, rubber, vinyl and other plastic floor coverings.
